

SANITARY MEASURES

French regulations related to the COVID-19 pandemic have been eased and specific health measures are not imposed on events such as Sunny Side of the Doc. However, Doc Services intends to make the health and safety of all participants a priority. Our goal is to give you a safe and stress-free market experience, and our team will support you when necessary.

Preventing COVID-19 risks is a shared responsibility and Doc Services asks all participants to play their part in ensuring that the market remains as safe as reasonably practicable.

We kindly invite our participants to follow and respect the below recommendations to the best of their abilities and with due respect to their peers.

PRIOR TO THE MARKET

POSITIVE OR SYMPTOMATIC

An individual should not attend the market if they:

- are showing COVID-19 symptoms such as but not limited to: fever or feeling of fever, coughing, headache, sore throat, muscle soreness, unusual tiredness, loss or change in smell or taste, etc.
- have been tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 7-10 days (duration depends on individual's vaccination status, check the [French isolation rules](#) if in doubt).

TRAVELLING CONDITIONS

The conditions for entering the French territory are defined depending on countries of departure. Make sure to consult the following French Government's modalities before preparing your trip:

DEDICATED COMMUNICATION

Participants will be reminded of health and safety measures before and throughout the event.

FACE MASK

Face masks are no longer mandatory in France, except in medical facilities and public transportation. Wearing a mask is recommended indoors during the conferences of the market but is not mandatory and at each individual's discretion. We ask participants to bring to bring their own masks, even though a back-up supply will be provided by the organiser in case of necessity.

HAND SANITISER

Hand sanitiser displays will be available throughout the market venue.

DISINFECTION

A dedicated team will be cleaning the facilities regularly.

CIRCULATION FLOW

The entry and exit points of the conference rooms with a capacity of 100+ persons will be on opposite sides.

EXHIBITORS

Avoid providing goodies and leaflets for visitors to pick up themselves. If you do decide to distribute such materials, have them distributed by someone. Opt for screens and contact-less communications as much as practicable, it's cleaner and greener! Hydroalcoholic gel and disinfectant wipes will be supplied on stand, by the organizer.

MEDICAL TEAM

Our onsite medical team will respond to anyone displaying COVID-19 symptoms.

COVID-19 TEST

The "Pharmacie du Gabut" conducts COVID-19 tests and is located at a 5-minute walk of the event venue (10 quai de la Georgette). Appointments can be scheduled on a [dedicated platform](#).
