



SUNNY SIDE OF THE DOC AND PIXII FESTIVAL REVEAL THEIR 2021 OFFICIAL SELECTION

Not only are our Pitch Sessions the cornerstone of Sunny Side of the Doc and a real opportunity for international co-productions, but they continue to be one of the most coveted and curated events at the marketplace, which takes place online this year from 21st to 24th June.

La Rochelle, 18th May 2021 – Sunny Side of the Doc can now reveal the official Pitch Selection for the 32nd edition, as well as the XR experiences that have been shortlisted for the 5th edition of PiXii Festival, a meeting point for creative storytelling and digital cultures.

It's all about sending out a strong message by shining the spotlight on diversity, independent voices and creativity at the international marketplace for documentary and narrative experiences!

This year, **42 projects from 18 different countries*** that stand out due to their originality, international potential and continuous search for new ways of storytelling will be presented during six themed sessions and tailored one-to-one meetings with support from our partners: **RTBF** for the Global Issues Pitch, **PBS** International for the History Pitch, **Science & Vie TV** for the Science Pitch, **West Lake International Documentary Festival** for the Arts & Culture Pitch, **The Redford Center** and **Love Nature** for the Wildlife & Conservation Pitch and **Ubisoft** for the Immersive Experiences Pitch.

Engaging projects pushing global change

Following in the footsteps of our central theme **#StorytellingMatters**, the projects selected highlight stories which affect our planet, shake our convictions and incite change for the future. 72% of the projects selected are created or produced by women.

"Not only do the works submitted offer wide range of diversity in terms of geographical origin, subjects tackled and the voices that shares them, but this 2021 vintage also brings the opportunity to discover bold and untold stories from different perspectives that we're not used to seeing" explains Mathieu Béjot, Director of Strategy and Development at Sunny Side of the Doc.

With more geo-political topics – especially covering Asia – lead by several international producers, it's a sign that the challenges facing societies across the world are having an impact well beyond their borders.

A timely "New Voices Award" in partnership with Netflix

PiXii Festival: a video library and immersive exhibition in the heart of La Rochelle

For the 5th edition of the international festival of Digital Cultures, PiXii Festival continues its strategy to drive networking, co-creation and collaboration between professionals from the creative and cultural industries around XR. An eclectic selection of seven XR films (360, 3 DoF and 6 Dof) as well as a podcast/vodcast series will be available from 7th to 30th June via a dedicated video library.

For the first time, in cooperation with leading cultural sites in La Rochelle, the event also expands its offer to the general public, who can come discovery nine immersive experiences from the official selection (Belgium, France, Germany, Denmark) at the Natural History Museum, Musée du Nouveau Monde, Tour de la Chaîne (CMN), the Aquarium and the city's SNCF train station. Ubisoft will present "Georges Méliès: virtual fantasies" out of competition, a virtual reality experience designed especially for the Musée Méliès, the new movie museum by Cinémathèque Française.

"Immersive technology is a fantastic way to help more people better understand crucial themes like the climate emergency, women's rights, migration and social change" comments **Stéphane Malagnac, PiXii Development Executive.** "This collaboration between PiXii and local cultural operators provides a great opportunity for museums, such as the Natural History Museum and the Centre des Monuments Nationaux, to become the backdrop for XR and foster collaboration between producers and distributors of immersive experiences."

The Sunny Side of the Doc 2021 digital platform will open its virtual doors the 7th June to industry delegates looking to organise in advance and take part in meetings at the Exhibitor Spaces or with Experts before the four-day international marketplace and PiXii Festival.

A press conference will be held online on Tuesday 1st June at 11am (CEST/UTC+2).


