The winner will receive €3,000 and two accreditations for #SSD24 in La Rochelle from June 24th to 27th 2024.

# DOCS FOR THE FUTURE: Mapping a Sustainable World

The world is facing major challenges: migrations, famine, health, education, gender equality, climate change, rising nationalism, etc. To achieve a better and more sustainable future for all, the United Nations has identified 17 sustainable development goals that go far beyond climate issues alone:

- ✔ Responsible Consumption and Production
- ✔ Climate Action

'The Sustainable Development Goals are the blueprint to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all. They address the global challenges we face, including those related to poverty, inequality, climate change, environmental degradation, peace and justice. The 17 Goals are all interconnected, and in order to leave no one behind, it is important that we achieve them all by 2030.'

Today, only 15 percent of the targets are on track and the international financial architecture is becoming increasingly unfair to developing countries.

**What about documentaries?** As documentary professionals, our ambition is to open minds, to decipher, to educate, to raise awareness about the major issues facing the world and to be an actor of change. However, we have to admit that the world is changing more slowly than we would like, and too slowly to ensure its own survival!

But we simply can't give up and we have to keep trying to make a difference.

After focusing on Women's Voices in 2022 and on Climate Change last year, Sunny Side's Global Pitch aims to continue mobilizing the documentary community around the major issues of our time, so that it can help to be a vector for change. Global Pitch 2024 is therefore intended to be about commitment and mobilization as well as analysis. It is the first part of our 2024 focus, which will look at Mapping the Future of our ecosystem and the documentary genre itself during our 35<sup>th</sup> edition in La Rochelle.



#### WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR

We are looking for stories that are important, powerful, original, committed and engaging, inspiring, moving, analytical, investigative, solution-oriented and dealing with issues and challenges linked to the 17 sustainable development goals in order to map what the world of tomorrow could and should be.

We are open to all forms of storytelling, to innovative narratives and even, why not, humorous and playful!

Our call is open to all professionals, whether confirmed or emerging, from every country in the world, to all types of stories, and to all subjects as long as they are linked to the 17 SDGs.

The aim of these two days of online pitching is to facilitate international coproductions and financing of projects dealing with global issues. You will have the opportunity to pitch and defend your project in front of around a hundred high-level international decision-makers representing major broadcasters, streamers, foundations, buyers and other financiers looking for impactful stories.

You will also have access to a wide range of qualified professionals, mentoring from industry experts, the chance to forge partnerships and find funding, meetings with your peers for potential future co-productions, and much more.

## **Eligible projects**

- All talents, whether confirmed or not, can apply: filmmakers, producers, writers, directors;
- All formats are welcome: one-offs, series, shorts and features, etc.
- Projects should be in advanced development. We do not encourage projects whose principal photography has been completed or which are in post-production;
- Projects should have the financial commitment from at least one third-party partner (broadcaster, platform, sales agent, supporting fund, foundation, crowdfunding etc.). A proof of the confirmed participation of all partners (LOC) is required;
- Submissions from all countries are accepted. Please check our special rates for submissions from the Global South and Low production capacity countries;
- Applications must be submitted in English.

# **Projects Assessment**

Projects will be assessed and selected by a jury of industry professionals based on the following criteria:

- · Power and originality of the story and of the storytelling;
- International relevance and potential for international coproduction;
- Financial feasibility;
- Without being a prerequisite, other elements will be taken into consideration, such as plans for an impact strategy or a green / sustainability certification.

- The official selection is released: 12 projects selected by a jury of industry professionals
- **Mentoring and coaching** week: our expert-mentors will accompany the selected project holders in the preparation of their pre-recorded video pitches for the Global Pitch, through an online work session
- Upload of pre-recorded video pitches [deadline: 30 January 2024]

## February 6-7, 2024: Online Global Pitch!

# If you are selected:

- PRESENTATION OF YOUR DOCUMENTARY PROJECT, which takes place in three stages:
  - Your **5-minute** pre-recorded video pitch (including your trailer) is aired online;
  - Followed by a **2-minute** live online presentation of the key elements related to your production (this presentation can allow you to focus on the artistic issues in the pre-recorded pitch);
  - Followed by an **8-minute** Q&A with international decision-makers, moderated by industry experts.
- **ONE-TO-ONE MEETINGS**: we will arrange at least three one-to-one meetings with targeted international decision-makers to discuss financial and creative issues in a concrete way.

#### AWARDS

- The best project, selected by a jury of documentary experts, will receive €3,000 from the Global Pitch sponsor(s) and two accreditations for Sunny Side of the Doc, which takes place from 24 to 27 June 2024 in La Rochelle;
- Other special prizes and invitations to festivals may also be awarded by our professional partners.

## Mid-February 2024 and beyond

- Debriefing with mentors
- PROJECTS OBSERVATORY: Sunny Side of the Doc's commitment goes far beyond the pitch session. We want to support the development of your project through to international distribution. Our Projects Observatory allows us to track your progress and share your achievements with the international documentary community.

The entire application process is carried out via an online platform and must be **completed in English only**. You will be asked to complete and/or provide the following information:

# **REGISTRATION FEE**

The registration fee is €90 excl. VAT and includes the right to submit a project and access all Global Pitch activities. Please note that a preferential rate (€45) is offered to professionals from specific countries and territories (with very low local production capacity or difficult local economic conditions for instance).

If your project is selected, you will be offered the opportunity to invite a co-pitcher free of charge to take part in all the event's activities. Any additional co-pitcher must be accredited with an Event Pass, at a cost of €45 excl. VAT.
